Brief Life History

Extract from 'nosorigines':

'Boutonnier et mouleur, né en 1633 ou avant, dans la paroisse St-Eustache de Paris; est repassé en France après 1662. Il avait épousé à Paris, en 1653, Jeanne LEVASSEUR, née en 1633 ou avant, fille du maître menuisier Noël LEVASSEUR et de Geneviève GAUGÉ ou GAUCHER, de la paroisse St-Leu-St-Gilles à Paris.' (Claude Gilbert).

Transl: Buttonmaker and moulder, born in 1633 or before, in the parish of St-Eustache de Paris; he returned to France after 1662. In 1653 he had married Jeanne Levasseur in Paris. She was born in 1633 or before; daughter of the master carpenter Noël Levasseur and Geneviève GAUGÉ or GAUCHER, of the parish of St-Leu-St-Gilles in Paris.

Fichier Origine:

Born ca 1625; marriage contract to Jeanne Levasseur dated 22 July 1650; his marriage to Jeanne was mentioned in the inventory of the estate of Françoise Gaugé (Jeanne's maternal aunt).

His parents were Christophe Drolet (died between 1631-1635) & Marie Godemer, (died before 15 May 1638, date of the inventory of her estate by Notary Martin Prieur in Paris). Siblings include a brother Antoine, born ca. 1622, & a sister Françoise, born ca. 1631.

After his father's death his mother Marie Godemer married Pierre Soret & had a daughter Marie, born ca 1636.

He was first mentioned in Canadian records in 1654.

Il est né à Saint-Eustache, Paris vers 1628. Contemporain de Louis-Charles Saucier organiste à St-Eustache né vers 1634.
